### Overview

The course will cover the key aspects of warehouse management, including planning and following the flow of goods through the controlled process. Delegates will also consider the various options available for warehouse layout and selection of both storage and handling equipment. The course also aims to develop a good understanding of the control systems and current IT solutions available to this sector of the Logistics Industry.

### Objectives

To enable delegates to understand and improve the operation of a warehouse and to be able to understand the issues relating to stockholding and its effective control. Delegates will be encouraged to actively identify improvements projects to be implemented upon returning to the workplace.

### Who Should Attend?

The course is designed for those managers and supervisors who are involved in the operation of warehouse and storage functions. The content will also be of particular interest to any manager who is in the process of planning or improving storage operations.

### Course Content:

### Duration

This course is planned to run over a 3 day period with a mixture of interactive lectures, exercises and discussion. Delegates will work on an extensive practical case study, utilising the skills learnt.
